


RESPECT-Whakaute

Respect honours the personal rights and dignity of people. I feel genuinely cared for.




RELATIONSHIPS - Whanaungatanga

SECURITY - Whakahaumaru


A feeling of safety, being well supported and a feeling of belonging. I feel safe and secure living here.





CHOICE - Kōwhiri

I am supported to make my own choices and decisions as much as I'm able.










CONTRIBUTION - Whai Wāhi

Participation in day to day activities of the home and community. I am offered opportunity to participate in activities that interest me.





ACTIVITY - Ngā Mahi a te Rēhia
