

#### **RESPECT-Whakaute**


Respect honours the personal rights and dignity of people. I feel genuinely cared for.



# **RELATIONSHIPS** - Whanaungatanga


Providing support and encouraging connections with family, friends and the wider community.

## SECURITY - Whakahaumaru


A feeling of safety, being well supported and a feeling of belonging. I feel safe and secure living here.



Participation in day to day activities of the home and community.







# ACTIVITY -Ngā Mahi a te Rēhia
